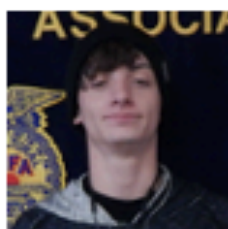


Jazmyne Elise Charles

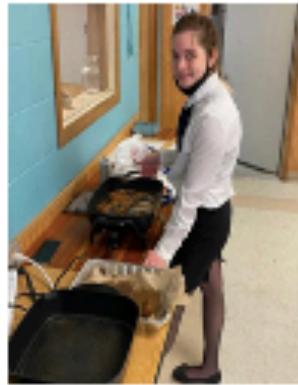


Masyn Arena

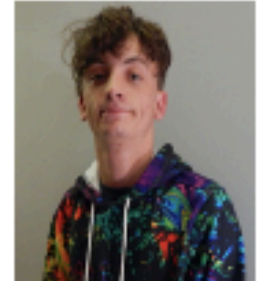

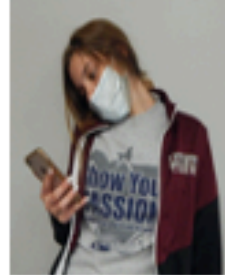

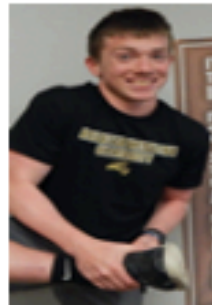
