It is important to remember two items when late starts occur. First, buses will run according to the announced late start. On December 8 at 1:00 p.m., the EducationQuest Foundation will be here to present information on Financial Aid. During the hour-long presentation, they will discuss college admission, types of financial aid, scholarships and FAFSA (Fee Application for Federal Student Aid) completion. All seniors will attend, but any senior parent is also welcome to attend. In addition, I will video tape the presentation and make it available on my website for any parent that would like to view it.


