
What: Scholastic Book Fair

Happy Valentine's Day!

February is a month of many celebrations. We have Valentine's Day (14) Ground Hog Day (2), Bubble Gum Day (2), LCS Week, FFA Week to name a few.

We celebrate our students' successes with MAP testing when they shoot for that perfect score or raise scores on each test.

Family and Consumer Science classes began second semester on January 15. Some classes were dropped. Some students chose other learning experiences outside the FACS classroom. When some students moved out, others moved in to experience learning about FACS.

The Family and Consumer Science department at Lewiston stresses hands-on education in practical skills that will be used for a lifetime. Standards in FACS were updated over a two-year period to reflect changes in our current culture. Students in Foods classes not only learn how to prepare food, but also the processes that go into new foods in the market place. The emphasis in Foods leans toward whole, nutritious food prepared in more natural ways. Students explore careers, learn how to keep financial records, how to use design in many different ways, places, and projects. Consumer skills, such as comparison shopping, evaluating products for length of product life, how to get the most for the money spent, help students to spend their money wisely. Learning how advertisements are made help students understand how and why products are marketed to their age group.

The Teen Living class is the introduction to FACS skills and the Senior Survival Skills class uses those skills as they prepare for living on their own.

Classes this semester will be based on the Career and College Readiness Standards developed by the Nebraska Department of Education. These standards emphasize people skills, communication, technical skills, and workplace ethics and skills.





- Your school counselor's office. Visit regularly to check on local and national awards.
- The college you plan to attend. Contact the school for a list of scholarships they provide and application procedures.
- National search sites such as <u>College</u> <u>Board</u>, <u>Peterson's</u> and <u>Chegg</u>.
- Other resources could include your coach, clubs and organizations, and your parents' employers and civic organizations.
