

Classes offered this First Semester include:

- 8th Grade Exploratory Class
 - 8th graders will have an opportunity to explore all the facets of FACS and some technology. This class is first period Monday through Friday.
- Textiles/Embroidery
 - Students in this class have the opportunity to learn to sew with textiles or work in the Lewiston Embrace Embroidery business.
- 7-8th Study skills
 - Study skills will be practiced three days a week, a Junior High Study Hall will be held one day a week, and then Fridays will be the time to explore a class project or individual passions.
- Foods 1
 - Students in this class will practice meal preparation, learn about necessary nutrients, and learn food preparation skills (and enjoy the food they prepare).

 - Juniors and Seniors are transitioning to be more self-supporting each year as they prepare to leave high school and be on their own. This is a class of easy and quick food preparation techniques and recipes.

 - Students pursue individual interests and create and design personal products following research into all aspects of their interest.

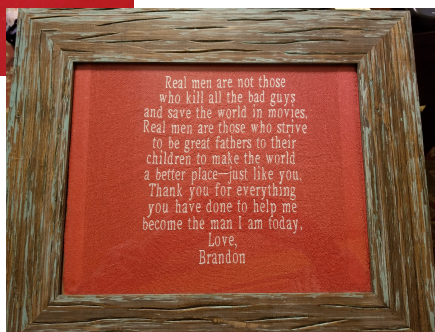

Juniors and seniors ... complete these college planning tasks during September:

- Seniors, apply to your top college choices.
- Seniors, create an FSA ID for you and one for a parent at fsaid.ed.gov.
- Juniors and seniors, attend a College Fair or Educational planning Program in your area.
- Before you attend a College Fair or EPP, register for a barcode at NebraskaCollegeFairs.org.
- Seniors, register by September 22 for the October 28 ACT.



Seniors...3 must-do tasks for this fall!

1. Apply to your top college choices.
2. Create an FSA ID. You and a parent must each create a username and password at fsaid.ed.gov that will serve as your Federal Student Aid (FSA) IDs for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You will each need your own email address to create an FSA ID.
3. Complete the FAFSA at fafsa.gov on or after Oct. 1. The FAFSA is your application for federal, state, and college-based financial aid. The colleges you list on the application will use that information to determine the types and amounts of financial aid they will award you.
