

Descriptions of Locally Sponsored Scholarships

Application Deadline April 17, 2015

The following locally sponsored scholarships will be awarded using a common application form. Please note the criteria for each of the following scholarships to determine if you are eligible for that particular scholarship. Indicate your desire to apply for those scholarships for which you are eligible by checking the box in front of each scholarship title on the application form. Then fill out the application form completely. You may **print neatly** the information on the application but all **attachments must be typed**. Be sure to include your name on each attachment to your local application. ***Recipient are required to attend the Lewiston Alumni Banquet Saturday June 6, 2015 to receive scholarships marked with a (*).***

“L” Club Scholarship: 1 - \$100 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from Lewiston High School. The student must be a member of “L” club. Preference will be given to a student who has not received any other aid at the time of the application.

Lewiston Alumni Association Scholarship*: 2 - \$100 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors by the Lewiston Alumni Association.

Lewiston Teachers Association Scholarship: 2 - \$200 will be awarded to graduating seniors by the Lewiston Education Association. Preference will be given to a graduate who plans to pursue a career in education. Students will also need to show evidence of active participation in school activities.

Lewiston LCS Club Scholarship: 2 - \$250 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors from Lewiston High School. They must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 and they must also have been active members of FCCLA/LCS for the four years they were in high school.

Lewiston Consolidated School Foundation Scholarship*: 2 - \$350 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors from Lewiston High School by the Lewiston Consolidated Schools Foundation. To be eligible the student must provide evidence that they have enrolled and plan to attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution. Additional criteria may include the most improved grade point average while in high school.

Farmers Bank of Cook Scholarship: 2 - \$250 scholarships will be awarded to a graduating senior from Lewiston High School by the Farmers Bank of Cook – Branches at Virginia and Liberty. Preference will be given to a student who attends Peru State College. The scholarship will be awarded upon receipt of evidence of enrollment.

Merna Wischmeier Memorial Scholarship*: 2 - \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors from Lewiston High School. These scholarship recipients will be selected and awarded by the family. Preference will be given to students in National Honor Society.

Herman and Malinda Bohlmeier Memorial Scholarship*: 1 - \$500

Lewiston Consolidated School Foundation* – Nelson Family Scholarship: Up to 3 - \$750 awards will be given to graduating seniors from Lewiston high School. To be eligible the graduate must:

- 1) be a graduating senior who has attended Lewiston Consolidated Schools for at least their junior and senior years of high school.
- 2) have a minimum ACT score of 22.
- 3) enroll and attend an accredited 2, 3, or 4-year post secondary institution of higher learning as a full-time student (12 or more credit hours each semester or the equivalent thereof).
- 4) have demonstrated in high school scholarship (50%), leadership and participation in school activities (25%), and citizenship in school and then community (25%).

Kiwanis / MUDECAS Scholarship: 2 - \$100 awards will be given to graduating seniors (1 male and 1 female) from Lewiston High School. To be eligible the students must have participated in a MUDECAS sponsored activity and must provide evidence that they have enrolled and plan to attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution.

Geraldine Miles Scholarship*: 2 - \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors from Lewiston High School by the Lewiston Consolidated Schools Foundation. Preference may be given to graduates with more financial need.

Learn to Dream Scholarship*: 1-3 – scholarship funded by the Lewiston Consolidated Schools Foundation and the Southeast Community College Educational Foundation for 1-full year of tuition and fees (45 credit hours) to Southeast Community College. A Learn to Dream Scholarship Application must be completed.

Knoche Family Learn to Dream Scholarship*: 1 – scholarship funded by the Knoche Family and the Southeast Community College Educational Foundation for 1-full year of tuition and fees (45 credit hours) to Southeast Community College. A Learn to Dream Scholarship Application must be completed.

Adrian P. Conratt Memorial Scholarship*: 1 - \$150 scholarship for a graduating senior who may be entering a medical field of study with financial need presented by the Lewiston Consolidated Schools Foundation.

Red Cross Scholarship: 3 - \$250 awards given to graduating seniors who have qualified for consideration as determined by the number of years they have served as American Red Cross Bloodmobile service volunteers.

Judy McCellan Memorial Scholarship*: 1 - \$300 scholarship given to a graduating senior who plans to participate in college athletics or an athletic related field of study.
