

Lewiston Consolidated Schools
Board of Education Special Meeting Minutes
April 28th, 2021

The Lewiston School Board District 69 held a workshop on Wednesday, April 28th, at 8:00 p.m. at the Lewiston Consolidated Schools Library. This workshop was open to the public and preceded in notice as required by law. The meeting was called to order by President Aaron Rule. Roll call found the following members to be present: Rule, Schuster, Searcey, Sisco, Thomas, and Wehrbein. Excused Absent: none. Also present: Michael Fakler, Jeff Emanuel, Kyle King, Jim Gustafson, Rick Kentfield, and several guests.

Moved by Searcey and seconded by Sisco “to approve the agenda as presented.” Those voting in favor of said motion: Schuster, Searcey, Sisco, Thomas, Wehrbein, and Rule. Those opposed: none. Motion passed, 6-0

Michael Fakler, representing Fakler Architects LLC reviewed construction bids for the proposed new vocational/agricultural building. Motion by Sisco and seconded by Thomas to “reject all bids received on April 27, 2021 for the construction of a vocational/agricultural building”. Those voting in favor of said motion: Searcey, Sisco, Thomas, Wehrbein, Rule, and Schuster. Those opposed: none. Motion passed, 6-0

After a decision was made regarding construction of the proposed new vocational/agricultural building, discussion was held regarding the future of the proposed new track complex. Jim Gustafson, representing the Nebraska Community Foundation informed the board that the anonymous donor planned to move forward with the construction of a new track complex with the understanding that the board plans to honor its commitment of building a new vocational/agricultural building at a later date.

Moved by Sisco and seconded by Schuster “to adjourn at 9:51 p.m.”. Those voting in favor of said motion: Sisco, Thomas, Wehrbein, Rule, Schustar, and Searcey. Those opposed: none. Motion passed, 6-0
