
## Lewiston Consolidated Schools Foundation NEWSLETTER

## Couple Has a Big Heart for a Small School

Curt and Sue Wischmeier were born and raised in Nebraska. They met in college, went to medical school, worked as an opthamologist and an anesthesiologist, respectively, and have spent most of their adult lives in Aberdeen, South Dakota. Why, then, would they be so committed to a small school district in southeast Nebraska?

"That's easy," said Curt Wischmeier. "They did a great job. I would have never gotten to where I am today without the great teachers I had. They were so dedicated to their students, and still are today. I know this because I stay in contact with my nieces and nephews who also graduated from the school.

Curt is talking about Lewiston Consolidated School. It serves the small communities of Lewiston, Bur-

chard, Crab Orchard, Liberty and Virginia. In 2008 – the year the Wischmeiers began making charitable gifts to support a preschool program – the school had a net loss of 28 students: 35 optioning out of the district and 7 optioning in.

This year the district has a net gain of 61 students and started the year with 214 students, the highest since 2003. Superintendent Rick Kentfield credits a lot of this success to the school's expansion of its 3- and 4-year-old preschool programs, thanks in large part to the generosity of the Wischmeiers.

Curt and Sue turned to Nebraska Community Foundation to carry out their continuing support of the Lewiston school district through a donor-advised fund.

"We didn't want to set up a private foundation on our own. That's like reinventing the wheel," said Sue. Curt added, "They're the experts in philanthropy. Jim (Gustafson) is always wearing a smile and always thinking about what can happen."

"Jim was essential to our charitable strategy," Sue said. "NCF's people helped us get there and do it. Preschool is absolutely important to both the children and to rural communities. Often rural communities just don't have the immediate resources they need."

"In these smaller school districts you have to give young families access to resources like preschool in order for your schools to grow," Curt said.

Superintendent Kentfield says that once the children enroll in preschool they tend to stay in the school district. It has proven to be an effective recruitment tool. School-provided transportation has been made available to bridge the 17-mile trip from Beatrice to transport students whose parents prefer to send their kids to a smaller school.

"The Wischmeiers are passionate about the school and have a deep-seated love," Kentfield said.
