January "To Do" List

Seniors:

- __ If you haven't already, complete the FAFSA.
- __ Apply for scholarships; see ScholarshipQuest for Nebraska-based awards.
- __ Update your Activities Resume.
- __ Request Letters of Recommendation for scholarship applications.
- __ Watch for acceptance letters and communication from the colleges you applied to.

Juniors:

- __ Update your Activities Resume.
- __ Research colleges that interest you.
- __ Register by January 6 for the February 11 ACT.
- __ Set up a ScholarshipQuest profile.

2022 – 2023 ACT TEST DATES

Test Date	Registration Deadline	Late Registration (\$36 fee required)
February 11, 2023	January 6, 2023	January 20, 2023
April 15, 2023	March 10, 2023	March 24, 2023
June 10, 2023	May 5, 2023	May 19, 2023
July 15, 2023	June 16, 2023	June 23, 2023

If you miss the regular deadline, you can register during the late period but must pay the additional nonrefundable late fee (\$36).

NOTE: All materials sent by mail must be RECEIVED by the last date of the late period, regardless of when they are postmarked. If students are wishing to register at school, he/she must have their social security number and a credit card to pay for registration.

TEST FEES

Registration for the ACT without writing is \$63.00.

ACT with writing costs \$88.00.

Juniors and Seniors qualifying for F/R Lunch may see Mrs. Houston for a fee waiver.

Seniors, complete your FAFSA
