





Seniors! A reminder of what to do this fall...

There's A LOT going on right now with the financial aid and college admission processes, but don't get overwhelmed! Here's a recap of tasks you should complete this fall to stay on track to college.

- First, create a Federal Student Aid account (FSA ID) for you and one for a parent at studentaid.gov. You'll need the user names and passwords to access and sign the FAFSA.
- Review the FAFSA Checklist at EducationQuest.org for items to gather before you start the form.
- Complete the FAFSA at studentaid.gov.

Apply to your top college choices!

Check out the EducationQuest *CollegeProfiles.* You can search colleges by name, location (anywhere in the United States), tuition rates, size of campus, majors, athletics, and more!

Retake the ACT. Some colleges will use your best scores for college admission and scholarships and your best score will be on your official school transcript.
