Format:

Four teams, single elimination

Game Times (No game will start before its scheduled time):

Tuesday, February 23th @ 6:00 PM: Game 1 – Seed #1 vs Seed #4

Tuesday, February 23th @ 7:45 PM: Game 2 – Seed #2 vs Seed #3

Thursday, February 25th @ 7:00 PM (Championship Game): Winner of Game 1 and Winner of Game 2

Home / Visiting Teams:

The HIGHER SEEDED team of the paired bracket will be considered the “home” team and will wear white jerseys. The “visiting” team will be the LOWER SEEDED team of the paired bracket and wear dark colored jerseys. (Eg. Game 2 – Lewiston is the #3 and wears maroon/Sterling is #2 and wears white)

Team Benches:

The "HOME" team will sit on the bench area to the LEFT of the scorer's table as you face it and the "VISITING" team will sit on the bench area to the RIGHT of the scorer's table as you face it.

Bench Supplies:

Schools should provide their own basketballs for warm-up. Water-filling stations are located in the elementary north hallway.

Team Warm-Ups:

After Game 1 on Tuesday, fans will be cleared from the gym. There will most likely be extra time on the clock if Game 1 ends early. Teams may not start warmup until the 20 minutes begins. Each team will be guaranteed a 20-minute warm-up.

Halftime:

Halftime will be ten minutes in length. Only players on the teams participating in the game in progress will be allowed on the court during halftime.

Scorer's Table:

Falls City Sacred Heart School will provide an official timer, scorer, and announcer for all sub-district games. Each team will also be allowed to have one scorer sit at the main scorer's table.

Doors Open:

One hour prior to the start of the first game.

Entrance to Building:

Admission:

Adults - \$5 Students - \$4

Passes:

Passes will not be issued. Only media passes and NSAA passes will be accepted. Per NSAA rules, each school will be provided 24 complimentary admissions to be used by coaches, players, student managers, trainers, and statisticians. The NSAA also allows for four (4) administrative supervisors. **Each school is responsible for assigning adequate supervisory personnel to ensure good sportsmanship. Roster / Eligible Players:

Your rosters have been made available by the NSAA. Players listed on the NSAA district entry form will be eligible to play in sub-district tournament games. Substitutions to this list can be made if needed because of illness or injury, but no more than 14 players may suit up for sub-district games. If substitutions are made, please inform the Tournament Director as soon as possible. Anyone substituted must be eligible according to all NSAA rules. Names for the tournament programs will be taken from the form submitted through the NSAA's website.

Team Bus Parking:

Buses/vans should park on the street or parking lot on the side their team was dropped off.

Locker Rooms:

Locker rooms/classrooms will be assigned upon arrival. Falls City Sacred Heart is not responsible for your valuables. If you have valuables that you need locked up please ask Mr. Goltz upon arrival.

Video:

Videotaping by competing schools will be done from the mezzanine on the south side of the gym. **Please bring your own extension cord if you need power. Thank you!**

Sub-District Basketball -- Falls City Sacred Heart COVID Protocols

Our goal is to make this an enjoyable experience for all student-athletes and keep all those entering the facility safe.

These are the current NSAA requirements for hosting sub-district and district contests:

- Active participants are permitted to wear face coverings during completion, but not required.
- Coaches and non-active participants are required to wear face coverings.
- Spectators are required to wear face coverings at all time.
- Attendance is restricted to 75% occupancy unless local health departments or host schools are more restrictive.
- The host may establish additional requirements. Any additional requirements implemented by the host school must be the same for all schools, officials and spectators.

Sacred Heart Home Games will be live-streamed.

Team Information

- We request that temperatures be taken of all those traveling with the team (athletes, coaches, managers, bus drivers) before traveling to Sacred Heart School.
- Pawnee City's and Sterling's teams should enter the **south** entrance into the Roh Activity Center.
- Lewiston's and Sacred Heart's teams should enter the **north** entrance into the Roh Activity Center
- Locker rooms/Classrooms will be provided upon request.
- Masks are required in Sacred Heart School.
- Athletes are permitted to wear face coverings during competition, but are not required.
- All athletes, coaches and bench personnel are required to wear face coverings on the bench.
- Score-table personnel must be masked.
- The home team will sit on the east bench (left as you face) and the visitor on the west bench (right as you face).
- Teams are to bring their own basketballs for warmups.
- Pre-game and post-game handshakes are prohibited.
- Teams are to exit the court immediately after their game concludes.

Fan Information

- We ask that all self-screen themselves before attending activities at Sacred Heart School.
- **Due to 75% occupancy each school is allowed 185 spectators per game. Gate Lists will not be required but the number of fans will be counted. Fans that arrive after the first 185 will be turned away. Spectators will only be allowed to attend the game their team is competing in. Please do not arrive early for the second game of the evening. Please leave immediately after the early game ends.**
- Pawnee City's and Sterling's spectators should enter the **south** entrance into the Roh Activity Center.
- Lewiston's and Sacred Heart's spectators should enter the **north** entrance into the Roh Activity Center
- Pawnee City's and Sterling's spectators will use the **south** bleachers. Lewiston's and Sacred Heart's spectators will sit in the north bleachers.
- South bleacher spectators will use the RAC south restrooms. North bleacher spectators will use the Elementary restrooms.
- **Face coverings are required and social distancing is required at all times.** Family members are required to sit together.
- Fans are to leave immediately at the conclusion of all games to limit gatherings.
- **CONCESSIONS** will be served.
- No cheerleaders or pep bands are allowed.

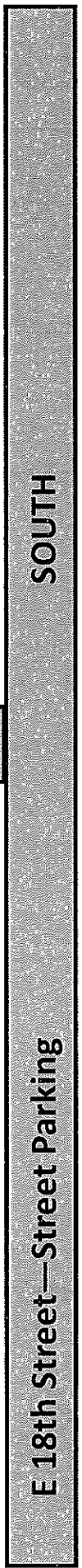
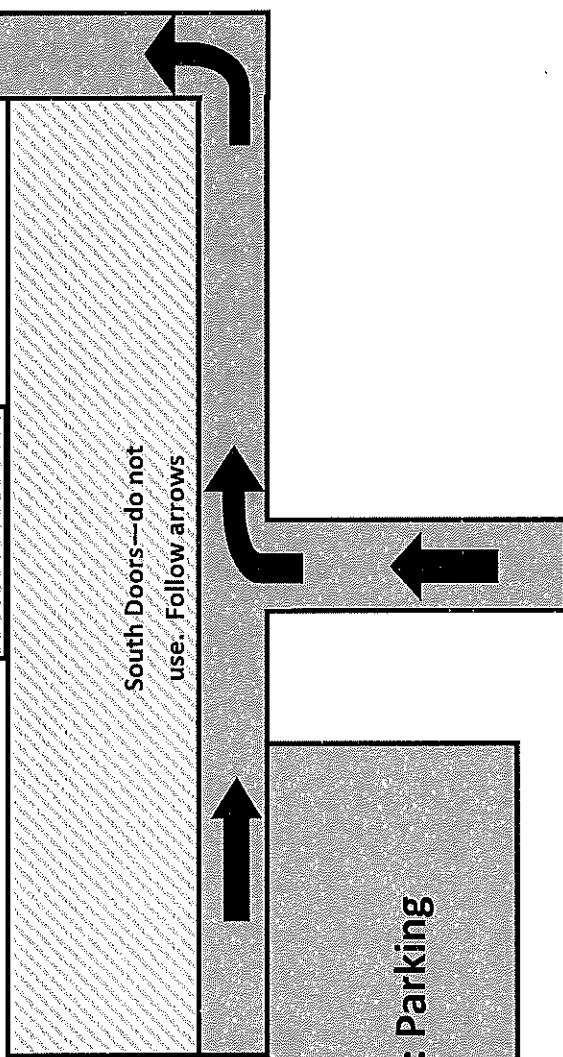
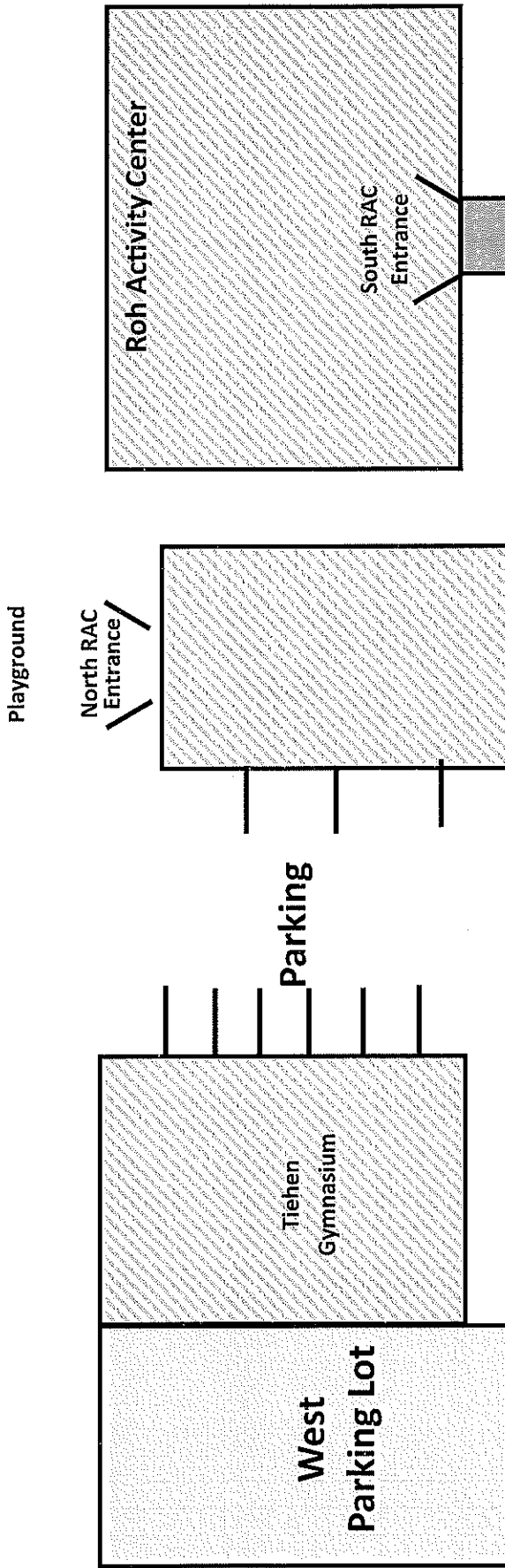
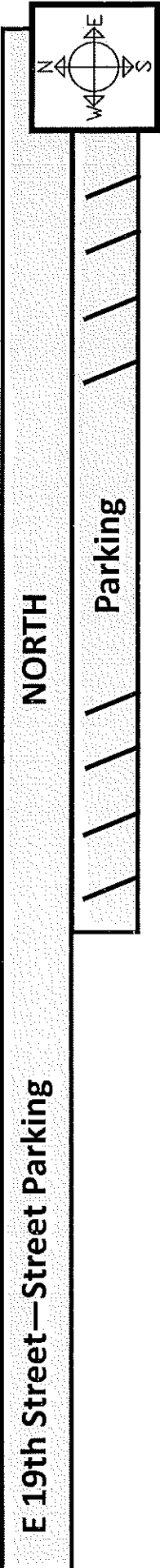
Enclosed are instructions for administration of the tournament.

The NSAA is implementing the following requirements for host schools of all NSAA winter sub-district and district contests:

- Active participants are permitted to wear face coverings during competition, but not required.
- Coaches and non-active participants are required to wear face coverings.
- Spectators are required to wear face coverings at all times.
- **Attendance is restricted to 75% of occupancy unless local health departments or host schools are more restrictive.**
- The host school may establish additional requirements. Any additional requirements implemented by the host school must be the same for all schools, officials, and spectators.
